

ORDINANCE NO. 2-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE STATE OF OHIO
MEMORIALIZING THE PREVIOUS APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE
CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE'S PORTION OF THE DESIGN OF THE
PANHANDLE TRAIL PASSAGE MADE BY MOTION AND PASSED AT THE
LAST SESSION OF COUNCIL IN 2010, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Uhrichsville, Tuscarawas County, Ohio, has authorized the appropriation of the City's share of the design cost for the Panhandle Trail Passage, said appropriation having been made by motion of Council and Adopted at the last Council meeting of 2010;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to memorialize the previous appropriation as an emergency ordinance in order to proceed with the City's obligations and to secure grant funding;

Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Uhrichsville, State of Ohio:

I.

That the Mayor, Auditor, Treasurer are directed to appropriate \$22,500 from City funds for the City's share of the cost of the design of the Panhandle Trail Passage.

II.

That this ORDINANCE is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety for the City of Uhrichsville and its residents, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members appointed or elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
